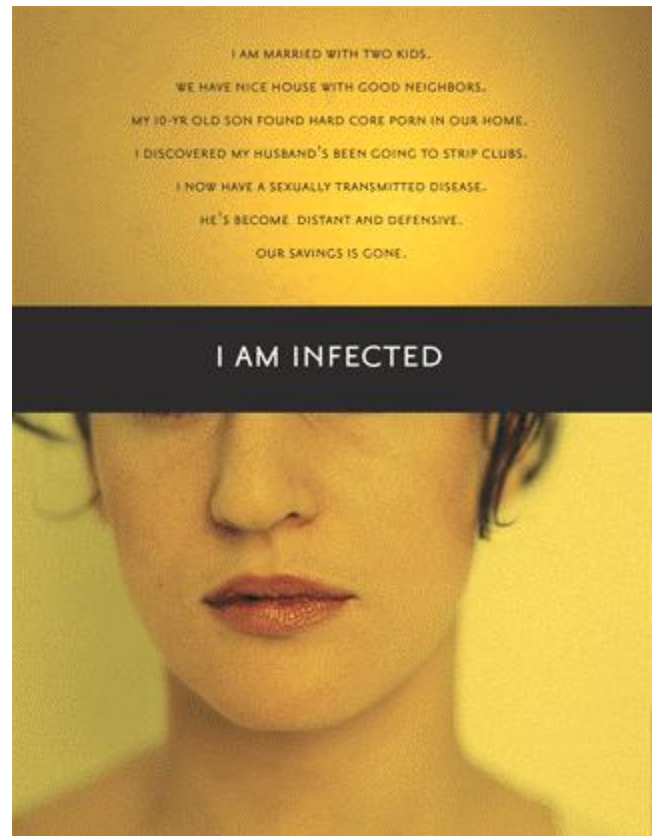




Marriage + Family

- American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers, during which surveyed lawyers claimed that an “obsessive interest in Internet pornography” was a significant factor in 56% of their divorce cases.
- A 2004 study published in the Social Science Quarterly found that pornography use increases the marital infidelity rate by more than 300%.
- Many partners feel that pornography is a devastating betrayal and describe pornography as just as painful or more painful than what we describe as a traditional affair/infidelity.
- More than 50% of those engaged in “sexual Internet interactions” had lost interest in sexual intercourse. 1/3 of their partners had lost interest as well.
- Erectile dysfunction caused by desensitization by an over-stimulating sexual appetite and a lack of physical sensation, desire, or intimacy with their partner.
- Men who engage a prostitute will have been viewing porn and need to escalate to human contact in a way their wife would not agree to.
- Addiction to pornography has resulted in:
 - 40% of “sex addicts” lost their spouse
 - 58% suffered considerable financial losses
 - 1/3 lost their jobs
- Severe clinical depression was reported twice as frequently among Internet pornography users compared to non-users.
