Dear Attorney General Pam Bondi,

I am writing in regard to the new Executive Order, [“Ensuring a National Policy Framework for Artificial Intelligence.”](#)

I am aware that the Department of Justice has been tasked with creating an A.I. litigation task force to sue states that have “overly burdensome” laws on artificial intelligence. As the term “overly burdensome” is undefined, I am concerned that **crucial laws protecting children from serious harms, or even death**, may be swept in.

AI is already being weaponized to exploit children online in horrifying ways:

- [Several children have died by suicide](#) after being **groomed and sexually abused by AI chatbots**
- [AI “nudifying apps” continue to appear in ads on social media](#)—deepfake apps that **strip clothes off real photos**, often targeting women and minors.
- Schools across the country are facing [AI-generated pornography and deepfakes of students](#), fueling bullying, blackmail, psychological harm, and the creation of child sexual abuse material.
- Experts warn [traffickers are exploring AI tools to groom, manipulate, and sextort minors](#) at scale, making prosecution and detection even more difficult.

It is *not* overly burdensome to require AI companies to protect children from these harms. **AI companies do not need data from the sexual exploitation of children in order to innovate and develop their models.**

In creating your new litigation task force, I urge you to ensure that no laws on child online safety are negatively affected. The lives of America’s children depend on it.
