


## Reddit Content Policy

(Retrieved of February 2022)

The [Reddit User agreement](#) says nothing about explicit or adult content.

Reddit does prohibit “sexual or suggestive content involving minors,” and “involuntary pornography” but only enforces the rule by threatening to ban Reddit communities, adding restrictions, or removing content. There are no meaningful age/consent verification requirements.

- Rule 2**: Abide by community rules. Post authentic content into communities where you have a personal interest, and do not cheat or engage in content manipulation (including spamming, vote manipulation, ban evasion, or subscriber fraud) or otherwise interfere with or disrupt Reddit communities.
- Rule 3**: Respect the privacy of others. Instigating harassment, for example by revealing someone's personal or confidential information, is not allowed. Never post or threaten to post intimate or sexually-explicit media of someone without their consent.
- Rule 4**: Do not post or encourage the posting of sexual or suggestive content involving minors.
- Rule 5**: You don't have to use your real name to use Reddit, but don't impersonate an individual or an entity in a misleading or deceptive manner.
- Rule 6**: Ensure people have predictable experiences on Reddit by properly labeling content and communities, particularly content that is graphic, sexually-explicit, or offensive.

Content is prohibited if it

- Is illegal
- Is [involuntary pornography](#)
- Is [sexual or suggestive content involving minors](#)
- [Encourages or incites violence](#)
- [Threatens, harasses, or bullies](#) or encourages others to do so
- [Is personal and confidential information](#)
- [Impersonates](#) someone in a misleading or deceptive manner
- Uses [Reddit to solicit or facilitate any transaction or gift involving certain goods and services](#)
- Is [spam](#)

### Prohibited behavior

In addition to not submitting unwelcome content, the following behaviors are prohibited on Reddit

- Asking for votes or [engaging in vote manipulation](#)
- [Breaking Reddit](#) or doing anything that interferes with normal use of Reddit
- Creating multiple accounts to evade punishment or avoid restrictions

### NSFW (Not Safe For Work) content

Content that contains nudity, pornography, or profanity, which a reasonable viewer may not want to be seen accessing in a public or formal setting such as in a workplace should be tagged as NSFW. This tag can be applied to individual pieces of content or to entire communities.
